- Visitors and contractors
- Chemicals / Hazardous substances
- Quad bikes and side by sides
- Trips and slips
- Electricity and Services
- Hand/Power tools
- Fall from heights
- Ladders
- Heavy Machinery
- Noise
- Sun/Extreme weather
- Traffic
- Stock water race
- Manual Handling
- Terrain
- Loading ramp (daylight hours only 6am-8pm)

- Electric fences (will be turned off during event)

- Rubbish -skips areas
- Environment – wind, earthquake, bad weather

- Gas – some sites have gas burners for cooking

Specific Emergency response:

- First aid kits are located inside the site office
- St Johns and Fire and Emergency will be on site during the event at site 415 and 416.
- Fire Brigade are also on site during the event (site 415 and 416 also) and will have tanker and vehicle stationed at Gate A ready.
- If a helicopter is required the landing pad will be located in the demonstrations area and a white sheet is available in the site office to be used as a temporary locator.

Chemical spill:

- Alert committee member
- Committee member will ensure that fire brigade is notified (on site)
- Area is fenced off
- Sawdust is put over the spill
- Committee member stays at site until fire brigade representative arrives

Electrical emergency:

- Contact a committee member
- Committee member will contact Daaron Reynolds and Hazard Co
- Fence off immediate danger
- Potentially evacuate site

Site Evacuation Procedure

- Contact emergency response people as appropriate (Fire brigade, police etc)
- Contact HazardCo
- Provide instruction over loud speaker for all exhibitors and public to move to marked assembly points.
- Committee members will be in high viz vests and will usher people to the assembly points
- Once at assembly will take instruction from Emergency services

Environmental Hazard

- In the event of a weather related Hazard, Organising committee Chairman Rodney Hadfield, in conjunction with immediate past Chair Alastair Robinson and the two current Committee members, Mark Lancaster and Richard Westaway.

Threatening people:

- If visitors or contractors display threatening or violent behaviour contact Rodney Hadfield or in an extreme situation with very threatening behaviour call 111.
